Thank you for engaging us to MAP your next steps in King County case # 19-3-002XX-31. This letter contains the results of our project.

In researching your case on KC Portal, we noticed that your final orders were entered less than one year ago. Upon discussing your case with you, we heard a significant change of circumstances sufficient to win an adequate cause to modify. As such, we can recommend that you file a Petition to Modify your Parenting Plan if that is what you'd like to do.

What we also learned was that your interest in modification has roots in the fact that your opposing party moved out of the school district without providing you the required Notice. We can confirm that no Notice of Intent to Relocate appears in the record, nor was one served in accordance with the instructions on Page 9 of your Final Parenting Plan entered in June 7th, 2019. This means that your opposing party has violated the Final Parenting Plan. This gives you even more options: (1) you could engage in a settlement discussion with your opponent (see AGREE), (2) you could ask a court to hold your opposing party in contempt of your parenting plan and pay your legal fees for having to bring that action, (3) you can do both, or (4) you can do nothing. You are under no obligation to act at this time. See attached a captioned blank Calendar Note, Motion and Order to Show Cause, Declaration, and Proposed Order should you choose to proceed and in person Proof of Service.
